**Discussion Guidelines**

- Choose one to two short passages (no shorter than 6 lines but no longer than 30!) that you read in English that you'd like to explore further in Italian (if you're not sure where to start, you can speak with me and I'm happy to provide some suggestions.)
- Develop 2-4 questions about each section.
- Questions should not be yes/no, but rather open-ended. They should prompt discussion with your classmates. They can be about the language or themes of the text, or broader cultural ideas you discussed with Professor Eisner in class (Use Reading Guide 1 as a model).
- Send the sections you plan to discuss and questions to the class by **Sunday at 5PM.**
- You can collaborate with your partner as much or as little as you'd like (you can also switch *canti* if you choose), but the idea is that you are there to help each other out.
